To be held during the ACS National Meeting:
August 17 - 21, 2008
Philadelphia, PA

This Symposium will bring together leading scientists in the fields of chemistry, sensory science, nutrition, neurobiology, genetics, epidemiology and other disciplines to present recent major advances that further elucidate the impact of taste, smell, and other chemosensory modalities on human health and nutrition. A more complete understanding of this topic will benefit human health by providing rich new avenues for development within the food, flavor, fragrance, and pharmaceutical areas.

The Symposium will extend over two or three consecutive half-day sessions (timing and duration to be determined by ACS). The Preliminary Program includes, but is not limited to, sessions on: • Taste, Smell and Flavor Mechanisms and Human Health • Chemosensation beyond the Mouth • Implications for Pharmaceutical and Food Industries

Review and selection of abstracts will begin on **February 15, 2008**, based on both topical relevance and scientific strength to foster a high-quality, focused, and interactive symposium.
